

Covid 19- New Guidelines from the Catholic Bishops of England & Wales:

Following the announcement by HM Government on 19th January that the measures put in place to mitigate against Covid virus transmission as "Plan B" will be lifted in full on 27th January, the following guidance is offered by the Bishops of England and Wales.

- The main mitigation against serious health issues arising from covid infection is to be fully vaccinated; this means two doses plus booster for anyone aged 16 or above. All those not yet vaccinated are encouraged to do so.
- Anyone displaying any symptoms of Covid 19 should stay at home and not travel to church or participate in person.
- Hand sanitizer provided in Church should be used when entering and leaving the Church building. All ministers of Holy Communion should sanitise before distributing Holy Communion.
- The practice of wearing face coverings (both covering nose and mouth) during the act of worship should continue.
- To ensure good ventilation/air saturation in the Church building. Given the current climatic conditions, this might imply wrapping up well when coming to church.
- Those engaged in any pastoral ministry which involves visiting the sick and housebound should ensure that the number of visits to different homes in a single session of visiting is managed.
- The sign of peace can now be offered again
- Holy Communion is to be given under one kind only (Sacred Host)
- Holy Water stoops may be refilled
- No need to complete Track & Trace Forms
