

# St John Fisher Church - Parking for mobility scooters – Survey results

## Executive summary

- a. In September 2016 the Parish Advisory Council (PAC) approved the publication of a study into the need for parking facilities for mobility scooters together with a simple survey of opinions.
- b. The study was presented to the Parish Annual Meeting in November and it and the survey, were subsequently published via the Parish Web-site and by paper copies.
- c. There were no paper returns, the on-line returns are listed.
- d. They are being discussed with the Parish Priest.

## Comments on the survey

The response was very limited (only 9 respondents). However of those 7 are in favour of making provision.

Two non-parishioners responded, one is known to your author the other gave as the email address 'no@...', replied 'no' to all questions and didn't have a preferred option; either a prankster or vehemently opposed to the idea. Had it stated that (s)he attended SJF perhaps we should regard the response as vehemently opposed, perhaps the choice of name does, however, suggest that the result should be included in any analysis.

Two of the respondents were present , or imminent, mobility scooter users. Surprisingly few of the respondents drive to Church and the only one who does may become a mobility scooter user. As a result we have no opinion from car drivers.

## Analysis

Seven of the nine replies supported the provision of proper parking facilities for scooter users. However opinions of the best locations were mixed: locations 3 (1 vote), 5 (3 votes), 6 (3 votes) and 7 (1 vote) being mentioned.

If any scheme is to go ahead then further study of the feasibility and cost implications of the location must be made.
