New Votive Candle Stands:

We are pleased to announce the installation of a new candle burning system. St Killian's candle burning system does not emit any smoke. After burning, the candle wax falls through a hole in the holder and into a water bath. It does not use metal holders so is environmentally friendly. This is a welcome addition for all our parishioners.

New Bicycle Stand:

We have installed new bicycle racks at the left hand side of the Church. We encourage parishioners to cycle to church if possible. However, for health and safety reasons, do not bring your bicycle into the Church so as not to block the exit doors. The bicycle stand can accommodate up to 10 bicycles at a time. Please, do secure your bicycles or scooters firmly.
